HOME- SCHOOL AGREEMENT

Child's Name:

At Eastfield we value working in partnership with you. It is vital that your child sees school and home working together for their benefit. By signing this agreement pupils and parents are agreeing to the following:

Eastfield Primary School will:-

- Encourage children to do their best at all times and make good academic progress.
- Encourage good behaviour through the School Values and nurture good manners.
- Encourage children to feel good about themselves.
- Treat all children and members of the community with respect regardless of race, creed, colour or gender.
- Inform parents of the children's progress at regular meetings and by providing an annual written report.
- Inform parents about what the children will be taught each term.
- Discuss any issues with parents/carers at mutually convenient times.
- Provide a relevant, balanced, appropriate curriculum that helps to ensure your child develops a lifelong love of learning.

Parents/Carers will:-

- Make sure your child arrives at school on time - 8.40am, ready for learning at 8.45am and is collected on time - 3.10pm.
- Make sure your child attends every day, on time, unless they are ill. You will need to provide an explanation if your child is absent.
- Ensure that family holidays are taken out of term time and arrange, wherever possible for medical visits to be taken out of school hours.
- Make sure your child wears the correct uniform to, at, and on the way home from the school
- Attend meetings to discuss your child's progress, one each term.
- Support the School Values, encourage positive behaviour and accept responsibility for tackling poor behaviour.
- Keep the school informed of any changes in family circumstances and ensure that your contact details are kept up to date and let the office know if any details change.
- Encourage and help your child to participate fully in all school activities as far as possible.
- Encourage their child to complete Home Learning on time and to the highest standard.
- Provide named school uniforms for their child, including a kit for PE, a book bag and outdoor clothing suitable for the weather.
- Approach the school in a positive and respectful manner to resolve any issues.
- Behave in a supportive, non-aggressive manner when supporting the school in competitive sports.
- Support all the school's policies including the medical policy, equality statement and efforts to tackle racism.
- Abide by the visitors' code of conduct.

Use of the Internet and Social Media

All parents are invited to join staff in setting a good example for our children by:-

- Ensuring that children's viewing and gaming is age appropriate so that children do not bring dangerous or inappropriate ideas into school.
- Never posting photographs or information about other people's children on any social media sites.
- Never making derogatory comments about other children, other parents, members of staff or posting photographs which could bring staff into disrepute.
